


Sample Action Verbs by Functional Skill Area and Bullet Statements

When writing your CV/resume, it's important to be clear, concise, and consistent. Don't write in a narrative form, or use first person singular pronouns.

Use definite articles selectively. Use short phrases and action words. The following action verbs that might be useful.
